Ewart Women's Christian College, Melrosapuram, Kancheepuram- 603 204 and represented herein by its and Principal and Secretary, hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", MENTEE institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors — in-office, administrators and assigns.

First PartySt. Christopher's College of Education, the Mentor institution and Second PartyC.S.I. Ewart Women's Christian Collegethe Mentee institution are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party'.

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party&Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their academic resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- B) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Training, to apply for NAAC Accreditation, improving best practices of the institutions, enhancing academic resources and infrastructure and developing the human resources.
- C) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoUfor advancing their mutualinterests.
- D) C.S.I. Ewart Women's Christian CollegetheMentee institution, the Second Party is engaged in training and Skill Development, in applying for the NAAC Accreditation.
- E) C.S.I. Ewart Women's Christian Collegethe Mentee institution the Second Party will be mentored / guided to apply for NAAC Accreditation.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution, the staff and the students. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for oneanother.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Partyby providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the Mentee institution, the Second Party for applying for NAAC Accreditation.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all the relevant agreements, deeds and documents as may be required to give effect to the training to apply for NAAC Accreditation. This MoU demands the Second Party to provide all the facilities needed in their premises for conducting Guest lecturers, workshops, seminars to apply for NAAC accreditation, improvement of Human resources (educating staff and students on NAAC) developing the best practices, academic resources and infrastructure.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the institution enhance their skills andknowledge to be eligible to acquire NAAC Accreditation.
- 2.2 Curriculum Design: Second Party will give the necessary information to the First Partyfor the training to modify, to add, to increase and to suffice the inputs for applying for NAACAccreditation.

2.3 Training & Visits:Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements forthe training; the Second Party to permit the Faculty of the First Party to visit the institution and also to conduct Training Programs for the Faculty of the Second Party. The training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the institution to have a deep knowledge and training needed to apply for NAAC Accreditation. The Second Party will provide space and other facilities forthe training of Stafffrom the Second Party and the IQAC coordinator of the First Party will be the coordinator.

2.4 Mentoring will facilitate the following

- Training of Faculty and staff of the second party for getting ready to be accredited by NAAC.
- Training to follow proper procedures, documentation, presentation.
- Sharing of knowledge, information and resources.
- Opportunities for research collaboration and faculty development.
- Guidance and encouragement to institutions to adopt best practices.
