Preamble

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between St.Christopher's College Of Education, 63, EVK Sampath Rd, Vepery, Periyamet, Chennai, Tamil Nadu 600007 and Department of Educational Psychology, Tamil Nadu Teachers

Education University, Chennai-97. This Memorandum of Understanding has been executed at Chennai on 07/09/2021 through the Chief functionaries of the parties.

- I. **St. Christopher's College of Education** was established in the year 1923 and this prestigious college is situated in Vepery, Chennai. It is an autonomous college affiliated to the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and prepares students for B.Ed., M.Ed., and M.Phil., Degree. The Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University has recognized the institution as a research center to conduct research leading to Ph.D Degree. The college has a Model School called, Bentinck Higher Secondary School for Girls, to provide opportunities for Internship to B.Ed. students. The college is one among the aided minority institution and governed by the Association of St. Christopher's College of Education.
- II. And whereas the **Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University** is an exclusive University for teachers education established in 2008, by the Government of Tamil Nadu (Act No 33 of 2008) to promote excellence in Teacher Education. This University is unique in nature relatively to the other Universities since its assignment is to promote excellence in teacher education and produce dynamic and smart teachers for the benefit of the society and the nation at large, with six Departments of Study and Research, namely: *Department of Pedagogical Sciences, Department of Value Education, Department of Educational Psychology, Department of Educational Technology, Department of Curriculum Planning and Evaluation, and Department of Educational Planning and Administration.* Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University awards B.Ed., M.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D. Degrees every year through the University Departments as well as through its affiliated Colleges of Education in Tamil Nadu.

1. Purpose and Objectives:

The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards the empowerment of the teachers. Hence, the parties desired to work together with the following objectives:

- 1.1. *To conduct and organize Integrated Webinars, Seminars, Mentoring Programmes, Promotions.*
- 1.2. *To encourage job opportunities, global openings and other possibilities without any financial dependencies.*

- 1.3. *To encourage the Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors and others to participate and contribute as resource faculty.*
- 1.4. *To establish a global stage for the students/teachers.*
- 1.5. *To strengthen the educational relationships between St. Christopher's College of Education and Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, for the welfare of the students/ teachers.*

2. Discretion:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

- 2.1. *That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and the Secretary & Principal, St .Christopher 's College Of Education.*
- 2.2. *That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/Institutions.*
- 2.3. *The Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and St. Christopher's College of Education agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement and that each institution may unilaterally withdraw after three months' notice to the partner.*
- 2.4. *The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and implementation of the programmes via video conference / face to face based on everyone's availability.*
- 2.5. *This Memorandum of Understanding is subject to the approval of the Syndicate of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University.*
- 2.6. *This Memorandum of Understanding is not binding any financial commitment in the part of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University implementing this Memorandum of Understanding.*
