Help at Hand – Strengthening Faculty in Counselling Techniques to Facilitate Gen Z 13.10.2018 to 20.10. 2018

With all technological facilities at reach, Gen Z has gone into a shell living in a virtual world rather than living in reality. As a result, they are all the more depressed than being happy, having lost connections with people on one-to-one basis. Studies show that they are least satisfied having various mental health issues. One of the striking developments is the increase in anxiety and depression as they are not happy and satisfied with themselves as well as the situation around them. Catering to such students, faculty handling them also tend to have unprecedented stress leading to burnout and fatigue. Having realized the trauma of Gen Z and their faculty, the college organized a training programme on counselling thereby strengthening the faculty to help Gen Z, know themselves and cope up in any circumstances optimistically.

The programme "Help at Hand – Strengthening Faculty in Counselling Techniques to Facilitate Gen Z" was held from 13th October 2018 to 20thOctober 2018. There were 73 participants who were divided into Batch A and Batch B.

The primary objective of the programme is to enable the college faculty to be trained counsellors and people-helpers through a systematic training programme and to equip themselves with the knowledge and skills of counselling techniques in order to extend a helping hand to students in wholistic personality development. It is necessary for the faculty to identify problems of the students and address them at the initial stages, since they are the first contact point. It will serve as an instrument to prepare the students to cope effectively in time of crisis and return to their usual level of functioning.

The objectives of the programme were to enable the college faculty

- Recognize the importance of integrating counselling techniques in classroom scenario
- Practice counselling and listening skills
- Develop the attitudes needed for a counsellor
- Imbibe temperament analysis
- Demonstrate counsel models, identify mood disorders & implement counselling

Passionate young committed and dedicated faculty of various Arts and Science colleges and Educational Colleges participated the programme. The participants received Accredited Certificates.
