15. General Impression

Students Satisfactory Survey 2018-2019

St. Christopher's College of Education aims at giving quality education services in the preparation of teachers. As a professional exercise, students satisfactory survey for the year 2018-19 was conducted and feedback was collected through Google form Questionnaire. A total of 146 students participated and expressed their views regarding the Autonomous set up, Examination system and other activities of the college.

Autonomous set up

Out of the 146 students, 110 students found the innovative practices in the college helpful and worthwhile to them. 123 students are happy that they had studied in the autonomous set up of this college. 124 students expressed that they have benefited a lot studying in the autonomous set up.

Examination set up

When asked about the examination system 124 students are satisfied by it. 115 recorded their views that they want the internal assessment to be continued. 65 students responded that they want 40 percent, 48 students expressed 20 percent and 19 students expressed 60 percent for internal assessment. The examination system followed in the college helped 109 students to change their study habits.

Internship

141 students expressed that the internship improved their teaching competencies.

Other Activities

125 students stated that social service activities were useful. 140 students have used the indoor stadium to play games. For 139 students, physical education classes were useful. 132 students benefited from the citizenship camp. 120 students found the field trip useful. Educational tour was enjoyed by 101 students. 138 students have mentioned that whatever they have learnt in the first aid classes would be useful during emergencies.

127 students have found family life education classes useful. Hundred and fourteen students have benefited from tea with advisory sessions.

Skill learning

For 138 students, assembly and quiz programmes have trained them in organisational skills. 137 students have learnt life skills from the fine art classes. House parties have moulded 124 students as socially matured persons. 136 students have mentioned that the activities of the college helped them in bringing out their inherent talents. 136 are confident in getting placement after completing the B.Ed. course.
