## **Students Satisfactory Survey 2016-2017**

The students' Satisfactory Survey for the year 2016-2017 was conducted at the end of the fourth semester. One hundred thirty students from the final year participated in the survey. Report is as follows:

From 2015-2017 batch, one hundred and twenty-two B.Ed. and eight M.Ed. students expressed that they were happy with the system of autonomy in the college. Student teachers had learnt to do their work systematically and the study habits of the students had improved. Students were satisfied with the prevailing evaluation system. Students felt that the Assembly Programme, Quiz Programme and House parties enhanced their skills to work in teams, provided opportunities to exhibit their talents and improved their organising skills. Many of the student teachers mentioned that model examinations provided a good practice for the Semester examination. Students enjoyed the educational tour. Students found the internship to be very useful which helped them to acquire teaching skills, understand about the school activities and the process of engaging students in classrooms.
