St. Christopher's College of Education was established in 1923. It is an autonomous College affiliated to the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and offers B.Ed., M.Ed., M.Phil. programme and research leading to Ph. D. Degree. The College is recognised by the Department of Education, Tamil Nadu, as a Teacher Training Institute and prepares Diploma Teachers who will teach in Primary schools. Opportunities for observation and Internship are provided for B.Ed. and D. El. Ed. students in Bentinck Higher Secondary School for Girls, which is governed by the Association of St. Christopher's College of Education and in other Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools in the city.

Note: Candidates who have taken more than one main subject in part III of U.G. degree have to choose and apply for any one of the main subjects in B.Ed.

Special Courses

Every candidate shall choose one special course. The special course shall be the subject that she has specialized at the major level in the degree course or in the post-graduate course.

M.Ed

- i. Pass in B. Ed Degree.
- ii. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities other the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University should produce an Eligibility Certificate from the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University at the time of admission.

D.El.Ed

- i. Pass in XII Standard Examination with minimum marks of 50% for OC, 45% for BC, MBC and SC.

- ii. Age: 30 years for OC / BC / MBC, 35 years for SC / SC(A) / ST / Physically challenged and 40 years for Orphans / Widows / Destitute. Inter-Caste Marriage – 32 years for BC / BC(M) / MBC and 37 years for SC / SC(A) / ST.

ADMISSION

- i. The Candidates Selected for admission will be instructed by a letter sent by post to the address given by the candidate or through e-mail or over phone.
- ii. The Candidate called for admission should report at the specific time and date with all her ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES and be ready to pay the College Fee.
- iii. The College is not responsible for returning any original certificate or testimonials, which are sent before the applicant is provisionally selected to undergo the course.
- iv. Those who discontinue the course after admission will not be admitted to this College again. The fee paid will not be refunded.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- i. ATTENDANCE: Attendance is taken daily. Those who arrive late are marked absent. No student will be released from training until the course is completed. A student who fails to keep adequate attendance for each aspect of the programme, including Lectures, Internship, Physical Education and Camp will not be permitted to appear for the examination as per the University regulations.
- ii. RELIGIOUS AND MORAL INSTRUCTION: Parallel courses are provided in Methods of Religious Education and Moral Education. Every student is expected to attend one of the courses.
- iii. MARRIAGE: Parents are advised not to arrange marriage for their daughters during the course.
- iv. PHYSICAL EDUCATION: All students must attend Physical Education classes regularly.
- v. INTERNSHIP: Internship is arranged in Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools in the city. Every student must satisfy the conditions laid down by the University regarding practical work and teach in any school, as arranged by the college.
- vi. LEAVE: The University requires that an accurate record be kept of the reason for any leave taken. Leave must be applied for and sanctioned in advance. Written applications for leave should be submitted atleast one day in advance. No student can avail leave for more than ten days in the year. If a student absents herself for five consecutive working days without applying for leave, her name will as a rule be removed from the roll of the College. No leave will be granted for any reason, whatsoever, in advance or in continuation of terminal holidays.
- vii. Students should not undergo any other Degree programme during the course of study at college.

HOSTEL ARRANGEMENTS AND REGULATIONS

Hostel is attached to the College. Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian meals are provided. If students leave residence in the middle of the year, fee paid will not be refunded. There are only a few single rooms, which will be allocated at the discretion of the Principal at the student's request.

The College hostel will be closed for Christmas Holidays and summer vacation.

The College reserves the right to dismiss any member of the Hostel for misbehaviour within twenty-four hours notice and will not be responsible for the refund of any payment.
